A year of national impact

In November 2022, Martha Stewart presented in Sante Fe, NM about Motivational Interviewing. She received a request to present an online follow-up for case managers in Minnesota.

In February 2023, Jo Ann Lee and Rhonda Evans provided a virtual train the trainer of the PIAL 7th-12th grade curriculum to child support staff in the state of Washington.

In May 2023, Jo Ann Lee and Rhonda Evans facilitated two presentations in Anaheim, CA: one about PIAL's teen dating violence awareness program ADMYRE and another about PIAL's College Sim and emerging adult curriculum.

Also in May, Amy Peters and Alison White facilitated a presentation in Savannah, GA about Voluntary Paternity Affidavit outreach efforts in Iowa. Several participants requested the Paternity Prep Packets (PPP) to potentially implement something similar in their states.

ADMYRE ONLINE/KITS

PIAL launched two free versions of Advocating for My Relationships (ADMYRE) which can be requested by schools and youth-serving organizations. One option is an in-person kit, which includes everything needed to produce the ADMYRE simulation packaged up and mailed to the organization. The second option is an online simulation which students can participate in virtually. Both options still include the debrief, which is a crucial piece of the ADMYRE program.



INTEGRATED VIDEO OF CASE MANAGERS

Instructional designers are incorporating video into child support process trainings on the LMS with child support case managers sharing their perspectives and knowledge to explain concepts. This not only puts a face with subject matter experts from different regions who other workers may have only interacted with over the phone or chat, but it also allows those with expertise to share with others the importance of a new tool or process. Integrating staff videos into training courses in this way makes a connection with those learning a new process, and many times this type of “show and tell” makes it easier for them to retain and use the information later.

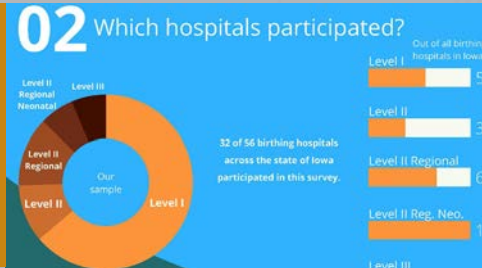

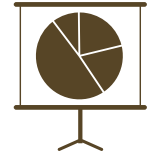

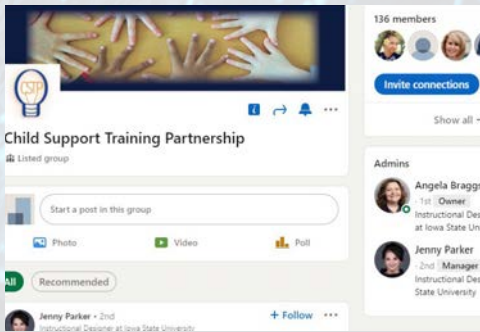
