NEW! COST OF RAISING A CHILD

PIAL is excited to share that our new and improved Cost of Raising a Child lesson is now available! The goal of Cost of Raising a Child is to inform students of common costs associated with raising a child and to practice prioritizing important financial decisions. Students start by watching an interview with young parents, where they talk about how their lives changed after having a child. Students then identify common expenses associated with raising a child and rate the expense categories.

Finally, students play the poverty simulation SPENT where they learn what is like to live in poverty with a child. Students have a job, and \$1,000 to get them through the month. As they navigate the month, they are faced with decisions where they have to practice prioritizing their important finances in order to make it to the end of the month with some income left over.
