Paternity Affidavit: What You Need to Bring

One current U.S. government issued ID:

- Driver's license
- State photo ID
- Work photo ID
- U.S. passport/visa
- Current school photo ID
- Military ID
- Permanent residence card
- Employment authorization card

OR two of the following current IDs: *(names and current addresses must match)*

- Expired driver's license, plus 1 other document in the same name
- Non-US passport, plus 1 other document in the same name
- Matricula Consular card, plus 1 other document in the same name
- International driver's license, plus 1 other document in the same name
- Foreign-issued voter's registration or identity card, plus 2 other documents in the same name
- Non-government issued identity card, plus 2 other documents in the same name
- Income Tax return
- Rent or mortgage receipts
- Car Title or Registration
- Court Documents
- Criminal Record
- Insurance Policy
- Banking documents – credit or debit card with photo
- Utility bill – current and same mailing address
- Medicare or Medicaid Card
- Medical Card
- Hospital Bill

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
